

Peterbilt 320 Dash Access Replacement Panel

INSTRUCTIONS

*The Peterbilt 320 Dash Access Replacement Panel is made from the same high-density material as the Peterbilt 320 dashboard. The Peterbilt 320 Dash Access Replacement Panel provides an additional 2" of space to make room for body company, scales, camera and other wiring installations.
Available for right and left hand drive vehicles.*

Each Peterbilt 320 Dash Access Replacement Panel includes:

- Dash Access Panel
- 1- bolt
- 1- white lanyard
- 1- white retaining washer
- 1- nut
- 1- clip
- 1- set of black velcro
- 1- U-Nut clip

Step-by-Step Instructions:

1. Remove the existing dash access panel AND the panel hinge from the dashboard. Attach the hinge to the Peterbilt 320 Dash Access Replacement Panel (Panel), using the existing screws/nuts.
2. Secure the Panel to the dashboard with existing screws and nuts. Lightly tighten the screws to allow for lateral positioning.
3. Insert the new bolt (included) through the top of the Panel. Slip on the lanyard (included) and white retaining washer (included). Secure the lanyard with the 5/8" nut (included) and secure the clip to the Velcro (included). Secure the Panel with the U-Nut clip (included).
4. Once the Panel is appropriately positioned, tighten any loose screws.
